

Many creatively

expressed their relationship through drawing images of who God is for them as a Father. A similar Lenten retreat was also conducted for a group of some 50 students in Maris Stella High (Primary) on 24 March 2023.

"Friends of the Cross" is the name of our Lenten Retreats conducted in the Montfortian Way. It is adapted and inspired from St. Louis Marie de Montfort's personal letter to an association of Catholics - called The Friends of the Cross - who were struggling with their own vices but wanted to repent and return to the Lord.
